PROPOSAL

The applicant proposes the installation of a life-size statue of Leslie Cochran on an existing street bench in front of the One American Center at the northwest corner of 6th Street and Congress Avenue.

PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The proposed statue will be crafted of bronze, and will depict Leslie in a seated position on the bench.


STANDARDS FOR REVIEW

Neither the Sixth Street nor the Congress Avenue historic districts have design guidelines addressing public art in the right-of-way. The purview of the Commission is to determine whether the installation of the statue is appropriate and compatible with the historic character of both historic districts.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval. Leslie Cochran was a local icon, and in his later years, was generally found on this corner. The statue will be placed in front of a non-historic skyscraper and is compatible with the character of both historic districts.
