

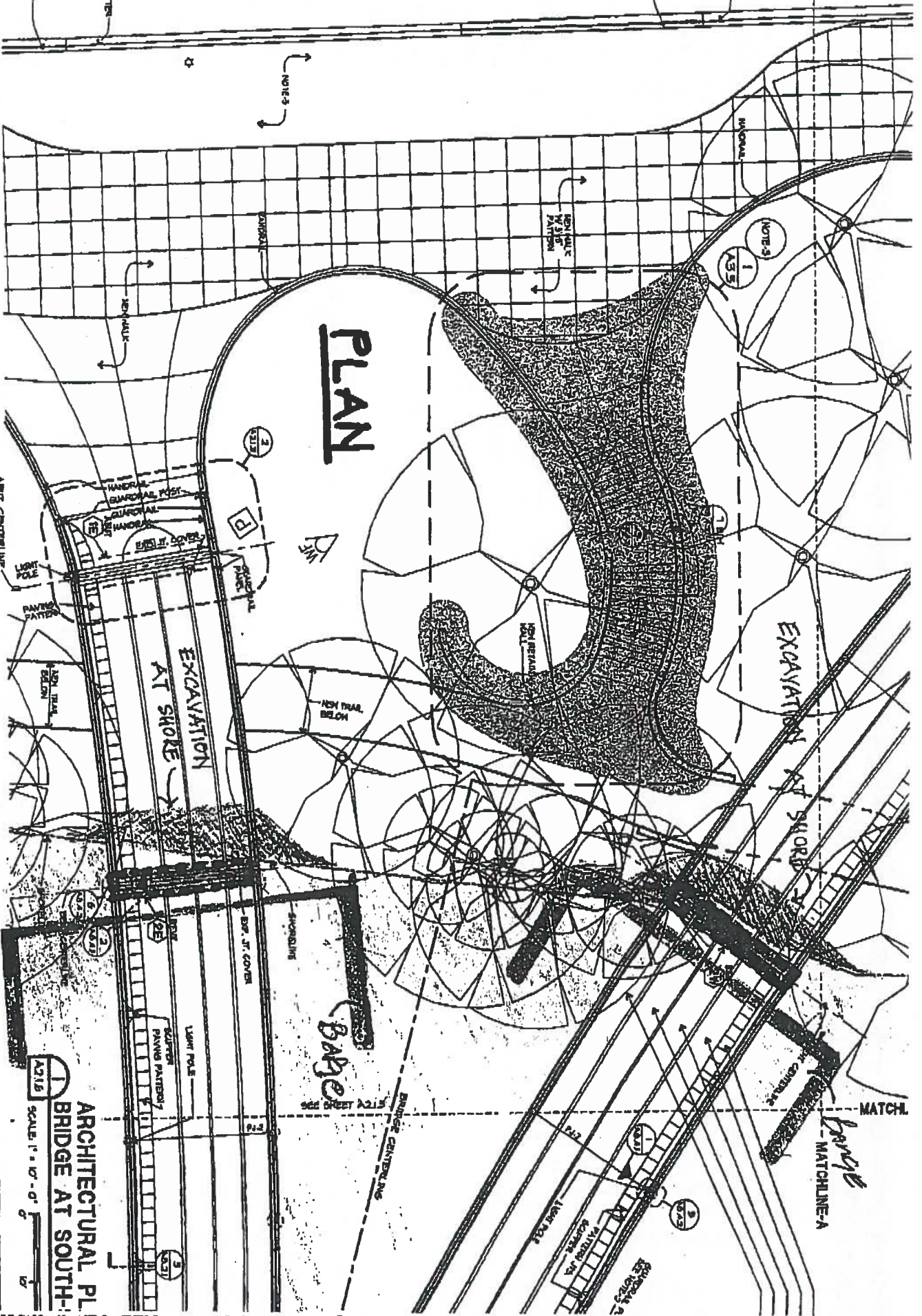

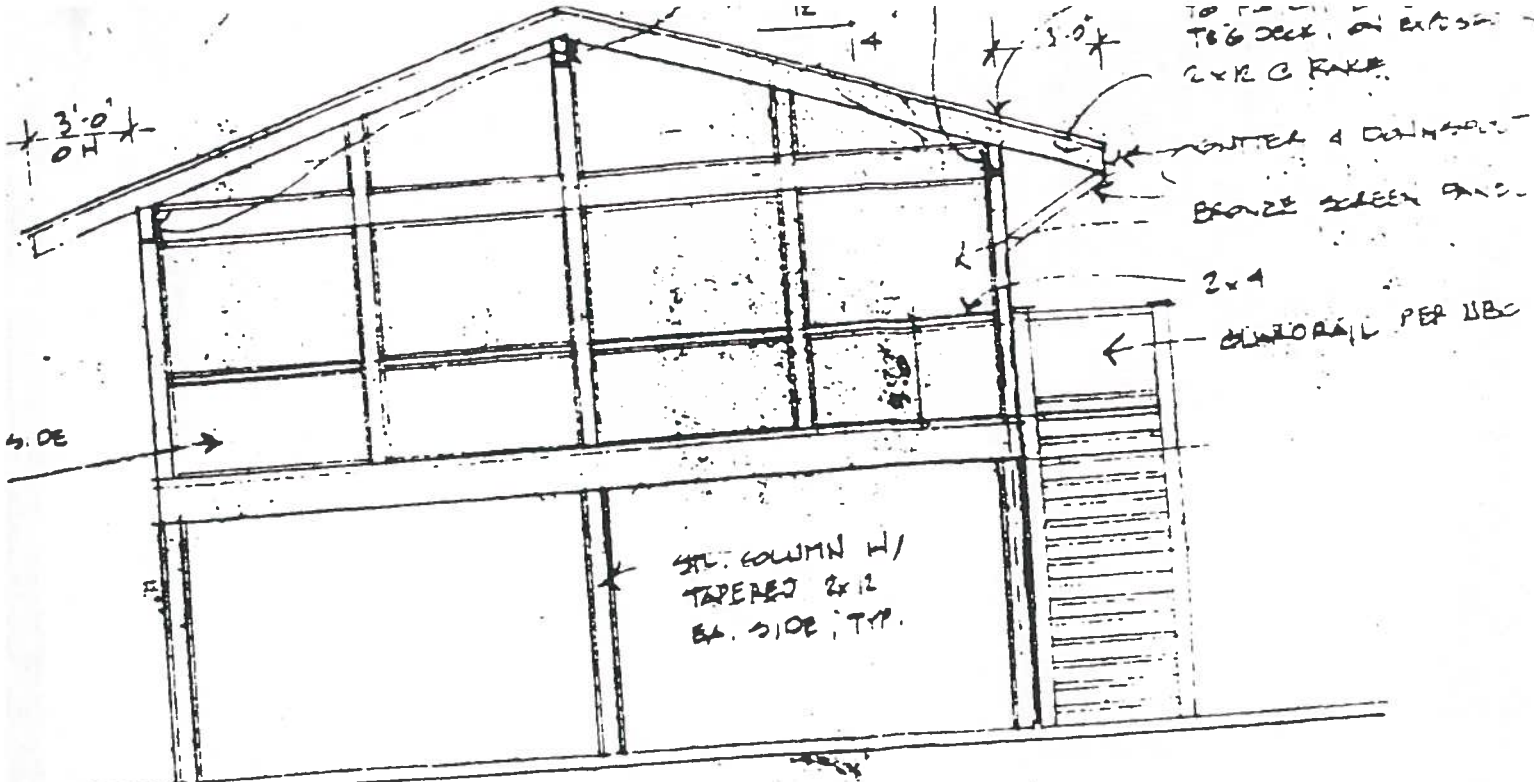
A request has been received from Signor Enterprises on behalf of Steve and Linda Yarbrough to construct a boat dock at 2105 Island Cove.

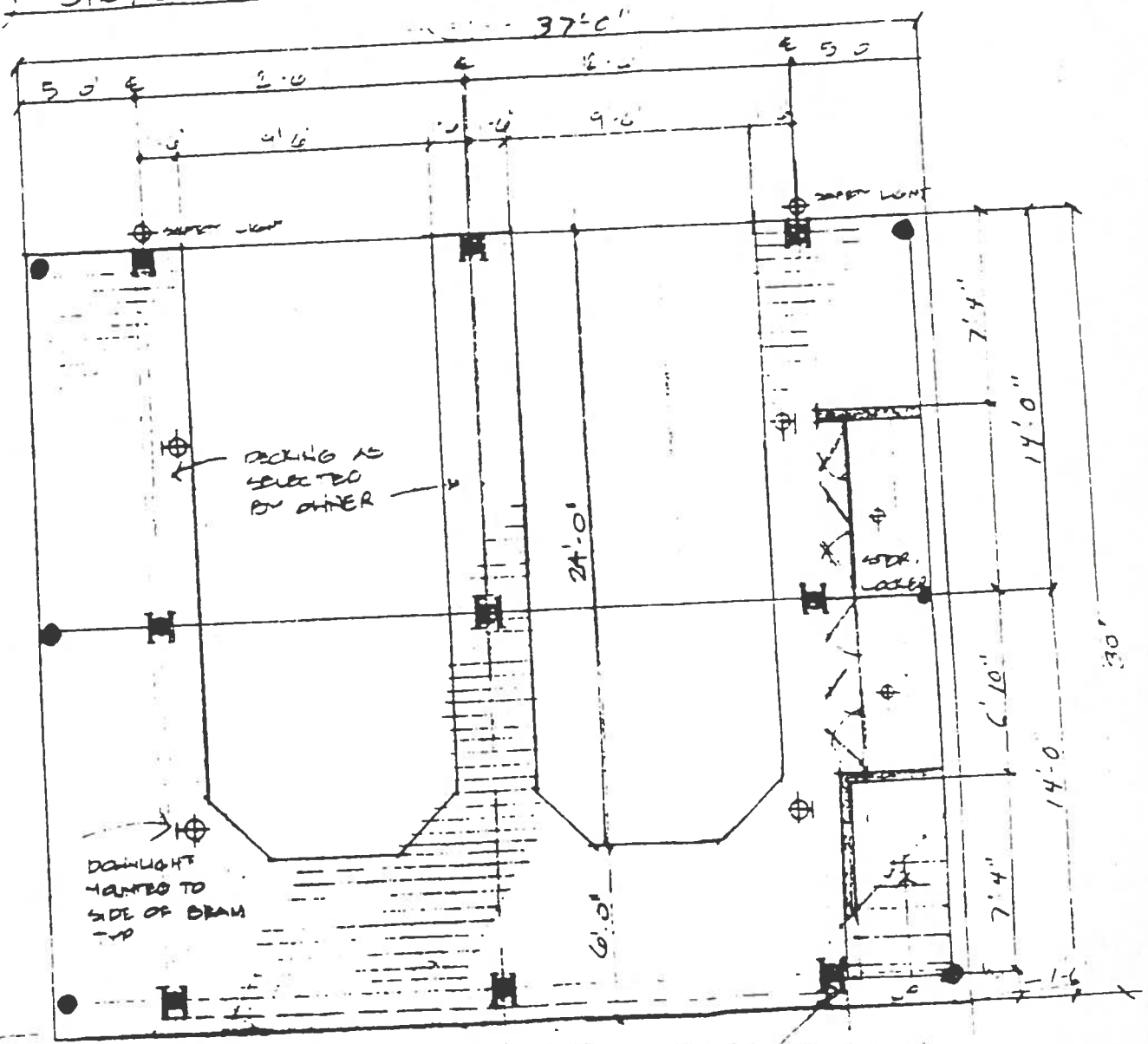

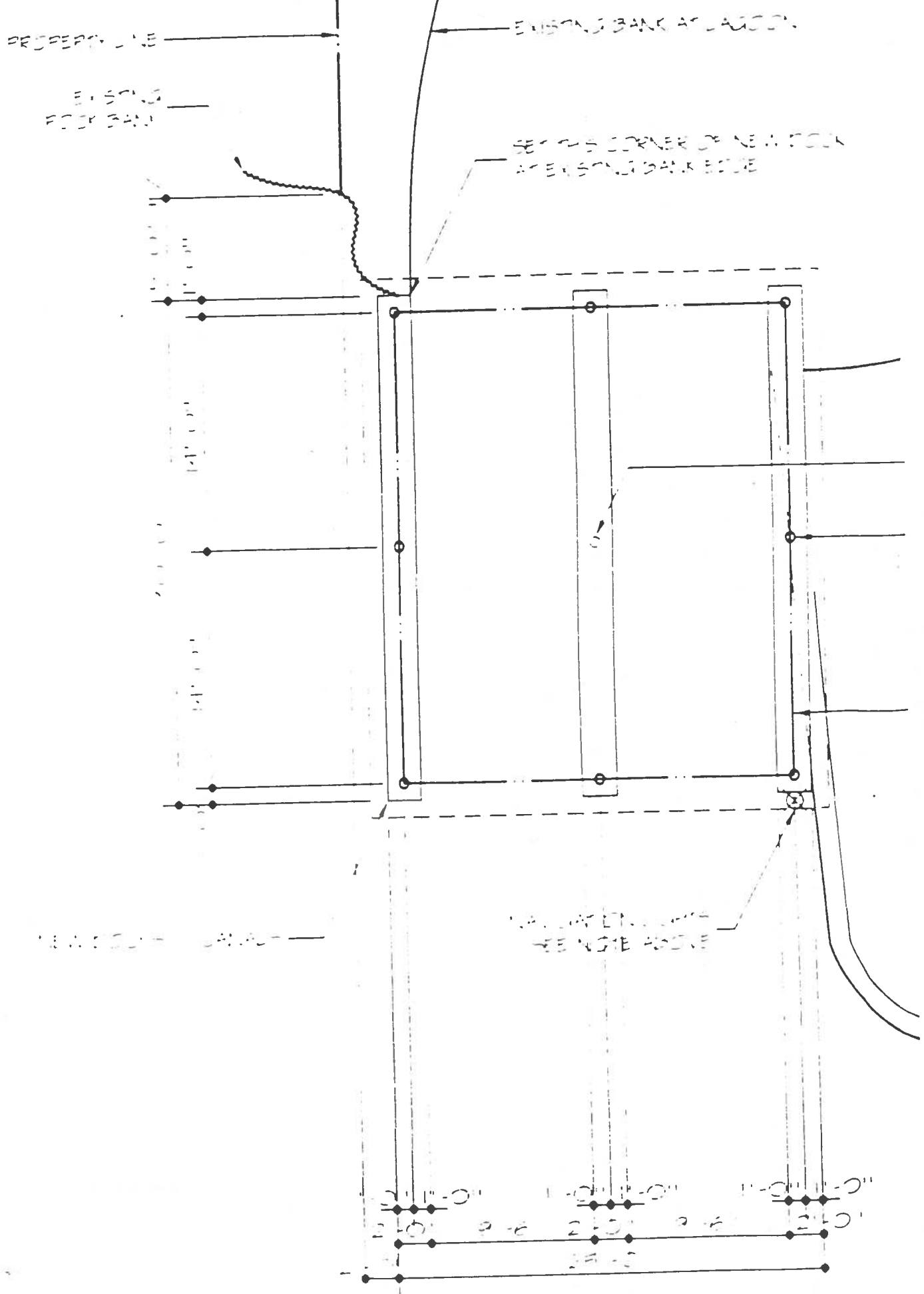


