#### HISTORIC LANDMARK COMMISSION AUGUST 22, 2016 DEMOLITION AND RELOCATION PERMITS HDP-2016-0527 2010 Ashby Avenue

#### PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1947 house.

#### ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled frame house with a partial-width inset porch; single and paired 1:1 and 6:6 fenestration; large, one-story addition to the rear of the house.

#### RESEARCH

The house was built in 1947 by Joe Adams, who did not live here. The first occupants were Arthur E. and Selma Bayer, who rented the house from around 1947 to around 1950. Arthur Bayer was an analyst for the State Department of Public Welfare. The house was livsted as vacant in the 1952 city directory, then occupied by Billie D. and Fonetta Simmons until around 1985. The city directory of 1955 shows Billie D. and Fonetta Simmons as rentes, but all later directories show them as owners. Billie D. Simmons was a printer who worked for Von Boeckmann-Jones, until the late 1960s, then went to work as a printer for the University of Texas. Fonetta Simmons had a business, Fonetta's Décor, on Barton Springs Road. They sepecialized in plaster.

#### STAFF COMMENTS

The house is beyond the bounds of any City survey.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Encourage rehabilitation and adaptive re-use, then relocation over demolition, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center. The house has neither the architectural nor the historical significance to warrant individual designation as a historic landmark.
