Staff Recommendation: Release the permit as proposed with the exception of the new covered entry – either remove the existing entry and don't replace it or replace it with something more minimal than proposed, and complete a City of Austin Documentation Package of the existing conditions at the house prior to release of the permit.

Staff Recommendation: Postpone to September 26, 2016 to fully evaluate alternatives to demolition and to fully understand the history of this house. If the Commission votes to release the permit, then staff recommends relocation over demolition, and completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package prior to release of the permit.

Davis' contributions to Austin's African-American community. If the Commission votes to release the permit, then staff recommends completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1949 industrial building.

Staff Recommendation: Postpone to September 26, 2016 or initiate a historic zoning case to determine feasible alternatives to demolition. The size of this building may determine a variety of uses, from music and art studios to retail, restaurants, recreation, or offices. If the Commission votes to release the demolition permit, then staff recommends completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.

While this house has been architecturally modified, it retains its basic form and a relatively high level of integrity, and every consideration should be given to preservation on site to maintain the vanishing context of E. 6th Street. If the Commission decides to release the permit, then staff recommends completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.
