## **Recommendation:**

Biosolids management planning should consider the following policies:

- •Honor the highest and best use hierarchy with the goal of prioritizing Class A Biosolids or higher as feasible (as reflected in the diagram below), except in emergency situations;
- •Ensure that the City maintains final decision for the disposition of biosolids with a Class B or lower classification; and
- •Preserve the Dillo Dirt trademarked name and compost quality, regardless of who produces the product.

## Class A Biosolids (not compost) — Rare at Hornsby in the past has been land applied or given away Land Application of Class B biosolids Land Fill
