I object strongly to the proposed demolition of this brick Tudor house. Despite the demolition by neglect attempted for over 20 years, this house retains its historic architectural features and character. Both the north and south sides of this block are currently intact. This would be the first gap, endanger nearby buildings, and degrade the neighborhood's historic character.

Historic housing in our neighborhood consists of buildings like this, that housed and continue to house people associated with UT, support staff and small business owners who contributed to our City in their own way. We don't have many large mansions or important historical figures, but there is community value in the collected urban design of these small bungalows, and every loss is damaging to the historic character of the neighborhood.

The current owner, and owner since 1978, Kirk Mitchell according to TCAD, has allowed the current state of building to come about by neglecting maintenance, despite the fact that he has the money to repair it. Is the house he owns next door soon to be on the chopping block also?

The present state of the building, though deteriorated and overgrown with vegetation, is not irreparable. Most of the exterior damage is minor failure of some of the brick arches, and unrepaired partial demolition of the chimney. One area of brick veneer is damaged above a window, due to water infiltration. The rest of the brick veneer and the concrete porch appear to be in good condition, without cracks, indicating that the foundation is likely sound. A new roof is desperately needed.

These demolition proposals are escalating, due to various development pressures, and are not likely to abate. We will lose this historic neighborhood if the City, Landmark Commission and staff do not support preservation. Please assist our neighborhood, and other historic Austin neighborhoods, in obtaining local historic historic district designation and preserving our City's vanishing historic character.
