Free Residential and Small Commercial High Bill Audit	\$0	Customer satisfaction initiative for residential and small commercial customers (includes HOWs). Reduce other administrative costs to accommodate.			
Weatherization Assistance Program	\$400,000	Add AC Tune up measure; Continue with Direct Install RFP process.			
Multi-Family Rebates	\$300,000	Support Mayor and Council affordable housing initiatives. Expand reach to properties that house low income customers. Evaluate adding AC tune up and rental resolution pilots.			
Power Partner Thermostat	\$300,000	Increase number of thermostat products available; supports increased solar penetration.			
Remote Energy Audit and Customer Lead Identifier	\$40,000	Allow customers and Key Account reps to identify energy efficiency measures and enable personalized outreach.
