**SUBJECT:** Approve an ordinance waiving or reimbursing certain fees and certain requirements for the Taste of India 2016 event sponsored by the India Catholic Association of Central Texas to be held Saturday, October 22, 2016 at the Asian American Resource Center.

## **CURRENT YEAR IMPACT:**

**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** The total amount of Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) fees for this event are \$1,093.25. This item waives \$1,025 in PARD fees, leaving \$68.25 in fees that have not been waived or reimbursed for this event.

As outlined in Resolution No. 021003-40, the remaining FY 2017 Mayor and Council fee waiver budgets will be reduced upon approval of this item by the following Offices and amounts: Council Member Houston, \$125; Council Member Pool, \$100; Mayor Pro Tem Tovo, \$200; and Council Member Gallo, \$600. Additionally, the Parks and Recreation Department's \$200 refundable damage deposit requirement is also being waived. Any fee requirements above this total are the responsibility of the applicant.

Waiving or reimbursing fees for this event results in unrealized revenue for the General Fund, Parks and Recreation Department. Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
