## Additional Backup Information

On June 14, 2012, the City Council adopted the Imagine Austin Comprehensive Plan through Ordinance No. 20120614-058. Pursuant to the City Charter, Article X, Section 5, all amendments to the comprehensive plan or element or portion thereof recommended by the planning commission shall be forwarded to the City Manager and shall be subject to review and adoption in the same manner as for the original adoption of the comprehensive plan.

Periodic amendments to the comprehensive plan help keep it viable. The proposed amendments are needed to support other City initiatives.
