The Board of Commissioners and HACA staff will conduct a Work Session to discuss:

1. HACA's phased transition under the Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD). Topics include:
 - Phase I implementation of the RAD program, including but not limited to construction schedules, budget, and temporary tenant relocation. Phase I affects Bouldin Oaks, Manchaca II, Coronado Hills, Georgian Manor, North Loop, Northgate, Shadowbend Ridge, and Manchaca Village.
 - Phase II Implementation of the RAD program, including matters associated with a straight conversion, rehabilitation, and redevelopment or additional density. The discussion shall include but not be limited to construction schedules, budget, and temporary tenant relocation. Phase II affects Chalmers Courts, Rosewood Courts, Santa Rita Courts, Meadowbrook, Booker T. Washington, Lakeside, Salina, Thurmond Heights, Goodrich and Gaston Place.
2. Austin Affordable Housing Corporation's development strategy and review of affordable housing trends in Austin.
3. Funding and budgets for HACA and each of its subsidiaries, including Austin Affordable Housing Corporation, Austin Affordable Public Facility Corporation, Southwest Housing Compliance Corporation, Austin Pathways, Pathways Asset Management, and Equity Community Land Trust.
