C. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Approval of minutes from the February 9, 2016 Impact Fee Advisory Committee meeting.

Committee Member (CM) Grijalva moved to approve, CM Parishner seconded and the minutes were approved 5-0-0-2 with CM Kallerman absent and one CM seat vacant.

D. VOTING ITEMS FROM COMMITTEE

1. Pilot Knob & Affordable Housing Fee Waivers Resolution to Council.

Discussion concerning the proposed resolution to council.

CM Turrieta described the origins of the resolution and the deliberations of the Water and Wastewater Commission, noting the concerns about preserving Austin Water's financial stability.

CM Bailey discussed the history of the Impact Fee Advisory Committee as it related to impact fee development and waivers.

CM Parishner noting that the resolution included both general guidance to council as well as specific prescriptions for dealing with future waiver requests.

CM Kallerman noted the absence of a clear cost benefit analysis supporting the decision to waive the fees.

Chair Bailey moved to approve, CM Fischer seconded and the resolution was approved 6-0-0-1 with one CM seat vacant.
