## Additional Backup Information

On November 3, 2016, the City Council approved the 2017 assessment rate for the East Sixth Street Public Improvement District (PID) (at the rate of \$0.19 per \$100 valuation), and approved the proposed 2017 assessment roll (list of property owners subject to the assessment). The assessments paid by property owners fund the PID services.

State law requires the City Council to conduct a public hearing to consider the proposed assessments. Approval of the assessment rate and proposed roll on November 3, 2016 triggered notices being sent to property owners, giving them an opportunity to review the property valuations prior to the public hearing. Property owners have a statutory right to challenge the assessment placed on their property at the public hearing.
