



What is High-Capacity Transit?

Transit that includes these features:

- Dedicated right-of-way or transit priority lanes (esp. during peak hours)
- High frequency (<15 min, or better) and extended service hours
- Significant, branded stations and amenities






Draft Purpose & Needs

The **Purpose** of Project Connect is to <u>improve existing</u> high-capacity transit and <u>develop new</u> high-capacity transit that provide efficient travel options to, from, and within Central Austin from the surrounding region.

The **Needs (Problems)** to be addressed by Project Connect:

- Explosive growth
- Limited ability to build more roads
- Issues of affordability / cost of living
- Implement a regional transit system






High-Capacity Transit Investment Corridors & Enhancement Projects






Review of Local Planning Efforts





What is an Investment Corridor?


- Roadway or railroad corridor that can support high-capacity transit
- May requiring alternative and/or Federal funding
- Purpose: Identify corridors studied for high-capacity transit <u>under</u> <u>previous local planning efforts</u>
 - Commuter Corridors
 - Connecter Corridors
 - Circulator Corridors





Commuter Corridors

- Serve regional trips from Study Area into Focus Area (Central Austin)
- Use express lanes within existing highways (i.e. North MoPac)
- Dedicate transit right-of-way / lanes within priority roadways




(all corridors considered mode neutral in Phase 1)



Connecter Corridors

- Provide access to, from & within the Focus Area (Central Austin)
- Major roadways & travel corridors
- Serve major activity centers



(all corridors considered mode neutral in Phase 1)



Circulator Corridors

- Distribute Commuter & Connector transit users
- Serve the activity centers of Central Business District
- Provide first / last mile connectivity



(all corridors considered mode neutral in Phase 1)



Draft Enhancement Projects

What is an Enhancement Project?

- Short implementation period
- Has potential to be locally funded

Purpose: improve <u>existing</u> high-capacity transit.

- MetroRail
- MetroRapid
- MetroExpress



MetroRail

Station upgrades, passing sidings, & park & ride spaces



MetroRapid

 Station upgrades, transit priority lanes, signal & intersection improvements



MetroExpress

 Managed lane access, park & ride spaces, & transit priority lanes
