#### 2016 YTD and 2017 Budget


### **Existing/retrofit rebates:**

2016 YTD: 2,000 rebates, \$550,000 distributed

2017 budget: \$560,000

#### **New Construction rebates:**

- 2016 YTD: 2,000 rebates and \$899,000 distributed
- 2017 budget: \$1 million



#### **Weatherization Program Highlights**

#### 2016 YTD and 2017 Budget

- Texas Gas Service matches weatherization rebates on duct measures and attic insulation for shared customers who complete Austin Energy's Home Performance with EnergyStar program.
- 2016 YTD Total: 1,628 participants and \$309,000 distributed.





#### **Free Equipment Program Highlights**

#### 2016 YTD and 2017 Budget

- In 2016, the Free Equipment Program had unusually high numbers due Austin Energy's grant for low-income weatherization. This has allowed us to replace 368 natural gas appliances in 2016 YTD (approximately \$790,000).
- In 2017 we are returning to the more typical budget level for Free Equipment at \$250,000.



#### **Commercial Highlights**

#### 2016 YTD and 2017 Budget

Highest commercial participation ever:

47 natural gas equipment rebates YTD 2016 vs. 20 total in 2015

- Direct Install Program:
  5,800 water- and energy-saving measures installed vs. 4,015 in 2015
- 2016 Commercial rebate total YTD: \$108,000
- 2017 Commercial Budget: \$146,000
