## **MOTION SHEET**

**Suggested Script: (read the following from the dais):**

I move to add a new PART 3 to the ordinance in backup to read:

**PART 3.** Parts 1 and 2 go into effect immediately. The City Manager, however, is directed to develop a process through which appellate authority is shifted from the director to the Austin Municipal Court, so that an individual disqualified from driving a ground transportation vehicle due to a criminal conviction and filing an appeal of the decision will be heard by a judge of the Austin Municipal Court instead of the director. The City Manager should include as part of the appeal process a requirement that the judge shall rely on EEOC Enforcement Guidance 915.002 (Apr. 25, 2012) when assessing whether to overturn the disqualification. The City Manager is directed to present this process and all necessary ordinance amendments to Council on or before March 1, 2017.
