- 48 acre District Park


Current Park Amenities:

Project Goals:

Create a Park Master Plan based on public input that will guide the Phase I Improvements.

Funds Available for implementation of Phase I Improvements: \$750k (2012 Bond)

- August 18, 2016 Informal meeting with lead stakeholder group
- September 2016 Online survey opens
- September 17, 2016 Info/survey table at Bull Creek District Park
- October 2016 Online Survey Closes
- October 27, 2016 First public meeting
- November 17, 2016 Second public meeting
- December 13, 2016 Third and final public meeting

Expert staff from Watershed Protection, Austin Resource Recovery, and Austin Water Utility were at the public meetings.

- Swimming at Bull Creek


How could we improve this park?
