ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This item amends the Operating Special Revenue Fund and Capital Budget of the Parks and Recreation Department to accept \$50,000 in grant funds. The purpose of these grant funds is to implement strategies to connect underserved populations with nature and provide personnel expenses for a temporary Program Coordinator position to oversee the implementation. A City of Austin funding match is not required. The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Parks and Recreation Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
