Additional Backup Information

The Emergency Medical Services Department (EMS) has partnered with Central Health to expand the Community Health Paramedic program since March of 2014. In Fiscal Year 2014, this partnership added one Medic II and in Fiscal Year 2015, two additional Medic II positions were added to provide more services to clients in need. Funding for this program expansion is available through the 1115 Medicaid Transformation Waiver. This agreement will provide more citizens with the proper resources to manage their healthcare needs by identifying and implementing navigation services through the healthcare system. There is no cost variance from last year's agreement.
