Recommendation

A motion was made by Commissioner Blaine against recommending the contract based on the points listed in the rationale section below. Commissioner Bones second. The motion was unanimously approved 10-0-0-1 with Commissioners Jiampietro absent.

Description of Recommendation to Council

The Zero Waste Advisory Commission voted against recommending negotiation and execution of a 36 month contract to provide citywide refuse, recycling, organics, and special waste collections for City facilities. RFP SLW0514

Rationale: The Zero Waste Advisory Commission cited the following reasons for their vote against recommending the proposed contract:

- Lack of diversion policies/goal
- Inclusion of the Austin Energy waste which is problematic for reasons that date back to original version of the contract rejected by Council
- Expansion of services
- Tripling of cost
- Lack of information about location of the landfill
- Lack of information about carbon footprint
- Concern about the impact of special events services
