#### Website Redesign




- OStarted with Intranet as pilot for new approach, design
  - O Alpha for Intranet (CitySpace) scheduled for release this month
- OCurrently building team for redesign project in partnership with CTM and Innovation Fellows
  - O Plan to formally initiate project on completion of CitySpace alpha
- OWorking to move Web from project to program
  - OBNS submitted for ranking and funding in FY18




# **Agenda Commenting**



- O Working with two startups to pilot possible solutions
  - O Civinomics & Polco
  - O Based on posting/integration of agenda data from portal
- ONew Agenda Management system may shorten timeline and improve integration
- O Any solution is not currently funded
  - O Additional funding for engagement/technology in FY18 forecast





# Reporting & Feedback



- Oldentified as a top priority for CPIO
  - O Limitations on practitioners actively managing digital engagement and posting of feedback data
- O Implementing on a limited scale, based on resources
  - O Spirit of East Austin feedback data
  - O Asian-American Quality of Life feedback data
- O Proposed FTE funding in FY17, not included in budget
  - O CPIO is resubmitting FTE for consideration in FY18 forecast





#### **Improved Engagement Portal**



- O Granicus/SpeakUp remains in flux
  - O Lack of support remains an issue
  - O Change in CEO in 2014, merger with GovDelivery in 2016 (and new CEO)
- O Piloting alternative technologies
  - O Innovation Office pilot (Insights), SoEA pilot (CityZen)
  - O Solution may be a suite of alternatives based on business need
- O Funding remains a challenge
  - O Currently only \$7K budgeted, new tools \$30K+
  - O Resubmitting request for \$32K in FY18 budget forecast








# Online Tracking of Policies




- O Requires consistent application of process through Council, Committees and Boards
  - OThis has been the core challenge. May be addressed with new Agenda Management system.
- Working on pilot with bond implementation/project tracking
  - O Relates back to project proposed by AFI Academy in 2014
  - O Technology may support implementation in 2017



# FY17 and Moving Forward



- OWeb redesign project is underway
- OContinue evaluating, testing supportive technology
- O Aggressively pursue funding to support activities
  - OFTE to support engagement technology and reporting
  - O Supplemental funding for online engagement
  - O Program-level support for sustainable Web development
