

State Planning & Projects

HJR 101 (Workman)

Development Board \$1 billion annual sales tax revenue for ASR or seawater desalination projects

HB 2948 (Larson)

- Creates an Interregional Planning Council
- Regional water plan requirements:
 - Identify "uneccesary and counterproductive drought response strategies, including outdoor watering restrictions"
 - GPCD goals for municipal user groups per decade





 HB 2005 (Larson) – TWDB studies of ASR projects and favorable areas







TCEQ Fees & PUC Appeals

- SB 1105 (Hinojosa) &
 HB 3026 (Phelan) TCEQ fee account merger
- HB 2369 (Nevarez) School district appeals of municipal water rates and fees







CCN Decertification

 HB 2187 (Lucio III) – Expedited release from a CCN (Certificate of Convenience and Necessity)







Drinking Water

- HB 2395 (Collier) Mandatory lead testing by all school districts and charter schools
- HB 3153 (Sheffield) Notice to TCEQ and Health
 Dept before reducing or terminating fluoridation

 HB 1573 (Price) – TWDB certification of water loss auditors

 Conservation and water
 resources curriculum for 8th
 grade science
