This request for council action is to amend the Aviation Department Capital Budget by \$72,000,000. This action will allow the department to proceed with contract amendments for Hensel Phelps, Gensler and Austin Commercial and related to the Terminal/Apron Expansion and Parking Garage & Administration Building projects.

\$28,000,000 in appropriation is needed to move forward with the Hensel Phelps (related item 68879) and Gensler (related item 68860) contract amendments for the increased scope of work for Terminal/Apron Expansion project. The Aviation Department and Airlines have identified additional needs that increases the construction cost limitation contract with Hensel Phelps and also the design contract with Gensler. The additional scope of work includes gate modifications, modifications to the mezzanine level, a centralized operations center, build-out of apron level airline tenant space and the replacement of aging baggage claim devices.

\$44,000,000 in appropriation is needed to move forward with the Construction Manager-at-Risk contract with Austin Commercial (related item 68565) for the construction of a parking garage, administration building and other garage entrance roadway improvements. A new 6,000 space public parking garage with highly desirable protected spaces will be constructed near the terminal building. A 70,000 square foot administration office building will be adjacent to the new garage and allow the Airport to free up revenue generating space on the mezzanine level of the terminal (currently occupied by several administrative groups).

Improvements to the entrances to the long term and close-in parking lots to improve traffic flows and new overhead signage on Presidential Boulevard are also part of the scope of the parking garage project.
