#### **RESOLUTION NO.**

WHEREAS, the City provides valuable services to Austin ratepayers in regards to refuse, recycling, organics, and special waste collection, processing and disposal for City facilities; and Austin Water provides services related to biosolids and compost; and

WHEREAS, the City enters into contracts with private companies to meet the goals for waste diversion set by City Council, and to protect the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, City Council must approve policy and certain contracts on behalf of the City departments; and

WHEREAS, the Austin community has a specific and important interest in solid waste policies and contracts due to the importance to our environment and waste diversion goals; NOW, THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

A working group is created, composed of four City Council members, to examine waste management and biosolids policy issues and contracts, especially as they relate to organics and recycling.

#### **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The appointments to this working group will be Council Member Leslie Pool, Council Member Ann Kitchen, Council Member Delia Garza and Council Member Alter.

## **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The City Manager is directed to provide the necessary resources to support the efforts of the working group.

#### **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The working group may expand the scope of the topics to be examined, to include issues such as Class 2 industrial non-hazardous waste, reusable items and other issues related to solid waste policy and contracts as it deems necessary.

# **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The working group shall provide its recommendations to the City Council by June 1, 2017.

### **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

Unless extended by City Council, the working group will automatically dissolve after providing its recommendations to City Council on June 1, 2017.
