General Summary of IPMC





General Summary of IPMC

- Regulates minimum maintenance requirements for existing buildings-
 - Residential and Nonresidential
- Intent: Protect public health, safety and welfare.
- Fully compatible with all International Codes-
 - International Building Code (IBC)
 - International Residential Code (IRC)
 - International Fire Code (IFC)





IPMC- model code

- Chapters of model code address maintenance/condition of:
 - Structural members/systems
 - Exiting (stairways, exit doors, egress windows)
 - Plumbing, electrical and mechanical systems
 - Weather protection, occupancy limits
 - Sanitation
 - Fire Protection

- Amendments to 2012 model code chapters 1-8:
 83
 - Wording changes, revised sentences additional language, some new sections





Local Amendments Chapters added to model code

- Chapter 13: Regulations related to transient lodging for public: Changes to be in effect after STR
 Ordinance comes into effect.
 - Hotel/Motels
 - Rooming & Boarding Houses
 - Bed & Breakfast
 - Short–Term Rentals (Oct.1, 2012)

 - Section 404.4.1 Room area- (added)
 - Section <u>404.5 Overcrowding</u>- (added)
 - <u>Table 404.5</u> (added)
 - Sections <u>404.5.1</u> & <u>404.5.2</u> (added)
 - NOTE: Required habitable room area per individual defined in amended <u>Section 404.4.1</u>
 - Section 404.6 Efficiency unit (addition) (added stipulation of 70 square feet required for not more than one occupant.





- Fifteen recommended changes to 2015 (cont.)
 - Chapter 6:
 - Section <u>602.2 Residential Occupancies</u>- (1 addition)

 Portable space heaters can only be used on a temporary basis depending at discretion of Code Official.





Chapter 7:

Section 705 Carbon Monoxide Alarms (1 addition)

Shall be installed and maintained.
