**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** Council previously approved \$200,000 in grant funding for the two-year Emerginand Acute Infectious Disease grant and \$97,000 in grant funding for the one-year Foodborne Outbreak Investigative Epidemiology Project, both ending on August 31, 2017. This request combines the two previously authorized awards and see the acceptance of additional funds for a total of \$415,591 for the combined grant programs. The new grant will cover a two year period (September 1, 2017 to August 31, 2019).

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Austin Public Health Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
