

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

WORK SESSION MEETING TUESDAY, APRIL 18, 2017

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Work Session Meeting on Tuesday, April 18, 2017 City Hall at 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Adler called the Council Meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.

BRIEFING

B.1 CodeNEXT Briefing – Mapping

Presentation was made by Greg Guernsey, Director, Planning and Zoning Department; John Miki, Associate, Opticos Design; Peter Park, Consultant, and Jorge Rousselin, CodeNEXT Project Coordinator, Planning and Zoning Department.

COUNCIL ITEMS OF INTEREST

Mayor Adler introduced the agenda for the April 20, 2017 Council meeting and allowed Council to give input or ask questions on any item posted on the agenda. Authorize negotiation and execution of all documents and instruments necessary or desirable to purchase in fee simple three tracts of land totaling 41.167 acres out of lots 1, 2, and 3 Block A Airport Commerce Park Section Three located at 838, 840 and 904 S. U.S. Highway 183 in Austin, Travis County, Texas, from SFSV HILL AIRPORT COMMERCE II, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$3,778,066 which includes closing costs (District 3).
- 30. Approve a resolution directing the City Manager to initiate revisions to the Allandale neighborhood and Rosedale neighborhood planning area boundaries. (Notes: SPONSOR: Council

Member Leslie Pool CO 1: Council Member Ora Houston CO 2: Mayor Pro Tem Kathie Tovo CO 3: Council Member Ann Kitchen CO 4: Council Member Alison Alter)

23. Authorize negotiation and execution of a 36-month contract with ECONOMIC & PLANNING SYSTEMS, INC., for financial analysis services related to real estate, economic development, and housing, in an amount not to exceed \$300,000. (Notes: This solicitation was reviewed for subcontracting opportunities in accordance with City Code Chapter 2-9C Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program. For the services required for this solicitation, there were insufficient subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established)

Direction was given to staff to provide copies of previous reports.
