

Where did allegations come from?


In the first half of the year, we experienced an increased portion of allegations coming through the hotline program, which includes a phone hotline and online reporting form.

How many allegations have we received this year?

This year, we received **112** new allegations. After a significant increase in FY16, the number of allegations decreased in the first half of FY17.



What types of allegations did we receive outside our jurisdiction?




How many investigations did we open?

We conduct due diligence review for any allegation that appears to be in our jurisdiction to determine if there is merit to it. If so, we open an investigation. We opened 8 investigations this year. This is fewer than this time last year, but a larger portion have resulted in reports.



What were the results of completed investigations?

We completed 11 investigations in the first half of the fiscal year.



The Ethics Review Commission has jurisdiction over employees, such as executives, commissioners, and other employees not covered by Civil Service.
