For the services required for this solicitation, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established.			
Additional Backup Information				

The contract is for broadband internet services for small, remote City department offices to access the City Enterprise Network Services. These offices are located in areas where the City of Austin Telecommunications Network (COATN) does not reach, many of which are located in Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) and neighborhood centers.

These services will also be used by Austin Water and the Communications and Technology Management department for direct internet services which provide metro ethernet services for the Greater Austin/Travis Regional Radio System (GATRRS) as well as dedicated internet access for the City's secondary enterprise internet connection.

This contract will replace the current contract with Time Warner Cable that expires on June 30, 2017. The new contract will provide a continuity of broadband internet services based on the same estimated annual service usage.

The State of Texas Department of Information Resources cooperative establishes competitively bid contracts that can be utilized by the State and other government agencies through a cooperative agreement. Cooperative agreements save taxpaver dollars by leveraging the State's volume-buying power to drive down costs on hundreds of contracts through a streamlined cooperative purchasing program.

A delay in approving or failure to approve this contract will result in a loss of internet connectivity to 8 remote public safety facilities, more than 25 public access personal computer labs located at several PARD recreation centers, 15 small City remote sites as well as the City's secondary enterprise internet connection.
