**Subject:** Proposed amendments to the Watershed Protection Ordinance

The Environmental Commission recommends approval of the proposed amendments to City Code Chapters 25-1, 25-2, 25-7, 25-8, 30-1, 30-4, and 30-5, as recommended by the Urban Growth Policy and Water Quality Regulations Joint Committee and with the changes discussed during the Commission meeting.

1. The recommended amendments are attached as Exhibit A.
2. The proposed amendments to Section 25-8-26 (*Redevelopment Exception in the Barton Springs Zone*), with the exception of the minor clarifications included in Exhibit A, are deferred to allow for further review.
3. The proposed amendment to Section 25-8-27(G) (*Redevelopment Exception in the Water Supply Rural and Water Supply Suburban Watersheds*) to allow on-site restoration as mitigation are deferred and shall be reviewed with the proposed amendments to the Barton Springs Zone Redevelopment Exception.
4. The proposed Sections 25-8-211(F) and 30-5-211(F), which exempt some agricultural facilities from water quality control requirements, are deferred to allow for further review.
