**Subject:** Proposed amendments to the Watershed Protection Ordinance

The Environmental Commission recommends approval of the proposed amendments to City Code Chapters 25-1, 25-2, 25-7, 25-8, 30-1, 30-4, and 30-5, as recommended by the Urban Growth Policy and Water Quality Regulations Joint Committee and with the changes discussed during the Commission meeting.

- 1. The recommended amendments are attached as Exhibit A.
- 2. The proposed amendments to Section 25-8-26 (*Redevelopment Exception in the Barton Springs Zone*), with the exception of the minor clarifications included in Exhibit A, are deferred to allow for further review.
- 3. The proposed amendment to Section 25-8-27(G) (*Redevelopment Exception in the Water Supply Rural and Water Supply Suburban Watersheds*) to allow on-site restoration as mitigation are deferred and shall be reviewed with the proposed amendments to the Barton Springs Zone Redevelopment Exception.
- 4. The proposed Sections 25-8-211(F) and 30-5-211(F), which exempt some agricultural facilities from water quality control requirements, are deferred to allow for further review.
