

Electric Board Approved MINUTES

BOARD MEETING June 21, 2017

The Electric Board convened in a Board Meeting on June 21, 2017 at One Texas Center, 505 Barton Springs Road, Room 300, Austin, Texas.

Board Chair Pomikahl called the Board Meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

- 1. CITIZEN COMMUNICATION: None.
- 2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes from the April 19, 2017 meeting was approved as written on Board Member Goss's motion and second by Dixon for a 8-0 vote. Portnoy absent for vote.

3. ANNUAL BOARD REPORT 2016: a. Vice Chair Johnson made a motion to approve the 2016 Report as written second by Goss for a 8-0 vote. Portnoy absent for vote.

4. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION:

a. Review the draft code amendment for the adoption of the 2017 NEC. The Board discussed the final draft ordinance and made the following changes:

- 1) Section 80.19(C)(2) remove the last sentence "In addition, an electrical permit shall be required to remove an Austin Energy meter seal."
- 2) Section 80.19(C)(3)(vi) remove the duplicate word "will", which was a typo.
- 3) Add a Section 700.10(A)(3) and copy 300.3(C)(1)(a) to the new section, "Emergency systems shall be permanently identified red in color."
- 4) Section 334.10(3) was added for clarification of Group R construction.
- 5) The Board proposed an effective date of January 1, 2018, once adopted.

Vice Chair Johnson made a motion to approve the draft ordinance as amended second by Board Member Friestman for a 8-0-1 vote. Weaver abstained.

5. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS:

- Discuss draft rule for the AE Criteria Manual.
- Discuss Solar ready installations.
- Discuss House Bill regulating electricians.
