
Required judicial ethics disclaimer...

- ▶ Municipal Court does not draft ordinances or determine how laws should or should not be enforced by law enforcement officers. Court jurisdiction begins after a citation is filed
- ▶ Judges do not make “policy” as to how the cases are resolved; this is the wheelhouse of the municipal court prosecutors and juvenile case managers
- ▶ The presiding judge/municipal judges and/or staff can provide information but are not advocating for any particular position

Statistics: Fiscal Years 2013-2016 (Nighttime Curfew)

- ▶ 433 **Nighttime Curfew** cases filed
- ▶ 119 Cases transferred to County Juvenile Court
- ▶ 157 cases diverted in Austin's Youth Diversion program (50%)
- ▶ 17 convictions (5%)




