### **Specific Service Category Changes: Criteria Factors**

### Payer of Last Resort Category (10%):

Aids Pharmaceutical Assistance Local priority ranking was reduced from an 8 to a 3

Emergency Financial Assistance priority ranking was increased from a 3 to an 8

### Access to Care and/or Maintenance in Care (30%):

Oral Health Care priority ranking was increased from a 5 to an 8

## **Specific Gaps/ Emerging Needs (20%):**

Housing Services priority ranking was increased from a 5 to an 8

**Emergency Financial Assistance** priority ranking was **increased** from a **3** to a **5** 

Outreach Services priority ranking was increased from a 3 to a 5

After extensive review the Allocations Committee decided to accept these Service Category changes and voted to move this Draft to full Business Council meeting on July 25<sup>th</sup>.
