

## **RESOLUTION NO.**

**WHEREAS**, at the August 10, 2017 Austin City Council Meeting two members of the eleven member City Council were out of town on official City business and as a result were absent from the City Council Meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 10, 2017 although the majority of the Council present voted to approve a motion for Item 23, case C14-2017-0072 (12611 Hymeadow Rezoning), with 5 members voting for and 4 members voting against, the motion made by the majority failed because there were neither six votes in the affirmative nor six votes in the negative and as a result the rezoning case was denied; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Council rescinds its action denying the rezoning of property located at 12611 Hymeadow Drive on August 10, 2017, and directs staff to mail notices of public hearing for case #C14-2017-0072 – 12611 Hymeadow Rezoning and place the item on the next available City Council agenda after notice has been sent.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The property owner or applicant shall pay costs associated with mailing notices of public hearing for case #C14-2017-0072 –12611 Hymeadow Rezoning.
