



The chart above illustrates the per capita for both types of Aggravated Assaults. The two charts to the right represent the two Agg. Assault types, Non-Family Violence and Family Violence —related. From this data the upward per capita movement was driven in 2016 by Non-FV Agg. Assaults. This is subject to change in 2017 depending on year end totals for FV-related Agg. Assaults.

Please note: In this analysis, "rate per capita" represents the number of robbery incidents per 100,000 Austin residents. Yearly population estimates were obtained from the City of Austin demographer.

2017 Highlights

- All 9 bank robberies have been cleared by arrest.
- 11 series thus far totaling over 75 robberies (13.42% of all robberies) 28 of these robberies were business robberies (28.28% of all business robberies.
- Suspects have been identified/arrested in 9 out of 11 of these series
- Successfully prosecuted one of the first Federal Hobbs Act cases in recent years
- This case stemmed from a series of jewelry store robberies throughout Texas and Ohio and resulted in convictions in 25 out of 27 charges.
