

Mr. Horn,

I understand that you recently contacted Ms. Findlay by phone wanting to know the status of the specific actions she has taken to resolve any alleged non-compliances purported by COA. Please be reminded that I am the authorized agent for Ms. Findlay (record owner) regarding all City application(s) per LDC 25-1-81 – any additional requests for information about the applications should be directed to me.

We specifically invited you to the June 7, 2017 OTC meeting which was called-for by the DSD and WPD Department Staff in response to our March 9, 2017 Site Plan Application. It was our hope that all assigned staff with authority would be present at that meeting, and that any/all of the issues purported by the three (3) separate COA Division's on this matter would be addressed comprehensively. However, we did not find any attendance by you nor the Austin Code Department at the June 7, 2017 meeting at OTC.

The City's online AMANDA data systems would erroneously suggest that the application has been deemed "inactive". Our efforts and requests to COA about reconciling this error have gone unanswered.
