CALL TO ORDER

1. EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Commission will go into executive session to discuss legal issues related to:

- a. A complaint filed on July 17, 2017, by Nathan Wiebe against Stefan Sasko alleging violation of City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure) (Private consultation with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Government Code).
- b. A complaint filed on April 25, 2017, by Nathan Wiebe against Margo Frasier alleging violation of City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure) (Private consultation with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Government Code).
- c. A complaint filed on August 3, 2017, by Abel Ochoa against Idara Bessard, alleging violation of City Code, Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure) (Private consultation with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Government Code).

2. PRELIMINARY HEARING ON COMPLAINT

Discussion and possible action regarding the following:

The Commission will convene a preliminary hearing under Section 2-7-44 of the City Code to consider a complaint filed on July 17, by Nathan Wiebe against Stefan Sasko alleging violation of City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure).

3. OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO PENDING COMPLAINTS

Discussion and possible action regarding the following:

- a. The Commission will consider witness and evidentiary issues under City Code Section 2-7-46 (Oaths and Requests for Information) relating to the final hearing on a complaint filed on April 25, 2017, by Nathan Wiebe against Margo Frasier alleging violation of City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure).
- b. The Commission will review, and may sustain or overturn, the chair’s initial determination that the Commission lacks jurisdiction over a complaint filed on August 3,

2017, by Abel Ochoa against Idara Bessard, alleging violation of City Code, Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure), and may refer the complaint to the City Auditor, in accordance with City Code Section 2-7-41 (Complaints).

The first five speakers signed up prior to the meeting being called to order will each be allowed a three-minute allotment to address their concerns regarding items not posted on the agenda.

Discussion and possible action regarding the following:

- a. Existing, dissolved, and potential future Commission working group tasks and membership, including the following:
 - 1) The working group tasked with recommending revisions to City Code Section 2-1-24 (Conflicts of Interest and Recusal), City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure), the Commission's Hearing Rules, and associated forms;
 - 2) The working group tasked with recommending revisions to City Code Chapter 2-2 (Campaign Finance), City Charter Article III Section 8 (Limits on Campaign Contributions and Expenditures), and associated forms;
 - 3) The working group tasked with recommending revisions to City Code Chapter 4-8 (Regulation of Lobbyists); and
 - 4) The working group tasked with coordinating production of the Commission's City Council election candidate forums as required by City Code Section 2-2-65 (Other Considerations for Campaign Contract).
- b. Possible revisions to City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure) and the Commission's Hearing Rules, including provisions relating to evidence submission, findings of violation, and issuance of sanctions in connection with the Commission's complaint hearings.
- c. Failure of Don Pitts to comply with a subpoena issued by the Commission and served on Mr. Pitts on April 26, 2017, ordering him to appear and testify as a witness at a May 10, 2017 final hearing on a complaint filed on February 17, 2017, by Nathan Wiebe against Ashley Buchanan alleging violation of City Code Chapter 2-7 (Ethics and Financial Disclosure), including a possible Commission recommendation to the City Attorney regarding prosecution of Mr. Pitts under City Code Section 2-7-99 (Offenses; Penalty).
