Additional Backup Information

The City of Manor has requested the release of approximately 27 acres of Austin's extraterritorial jurisdiction ("ETJ") to be included in Manor's ETJ. This area is located south of the City of Manor and east of FM 973. In addition, Manor has agreed to disannex and release approximately 7 acres to Austin's ETJ.

Adjusting the boundary between the two cities to better align with proposed new development will allow existing and proposed roads to be operated and maintained under one jurisdiction, achieve more logical boundaries, and ensure efficient public safety response.

This exchange should be made as a continuing process in regional coordination and cooperation with our neighboring jurisdictions. Staff recommends approval of this exchange of ETJ.
