Purchasing

Authorize award and execution of a contract with Elastec, Inc., to provide two pontoon boats, motors, and trailers, in an amount not to exceed \$116,080. (Note: This solicitation was reviewed for subcontracting opportunities in accordance with City Code Chapter 2-9D Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program. For the goods required for this solicitation, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established.)

Fiscal Note	Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Capital Budget of Fleet Services.
Purchasing Language	The Purchasing Office issued an Invitation for Bids (IFB) ELL0046 for these goods. The solicitation issued on June 12, 2017 and it closed on July 6, 2017. One offer was received, the recommended contractor submitted the sole responsive offer. Additional Backup Information:

The contract is for the purchase of a replacement 19 foot pontoon boat with outboard engine and trailer to be utilized on Ladybird Lake and an additional 16 foot pontoon boat with outboard engine and trailer that will be utilized by the Waller Creek Tunnel Operations and Maintenance group. These boats will collect trash and debris from the Waterloo Park Inlet Pond and provide stable working platforms for gate maintenance at the Waller Creek Tunnel Outlet Facility. Trash and debris will be removed from the Waterloo Pond on a weekly basis and during storm events by allowing staff the ability to quickly remove excess debris from the pond to prevent it from collecting on the bar screens.

The additional boat has been recommended for purchase by the Fleet Officer, affected Department Director, and Assistant City Manager (ACM). ACM approval is required for all new additions to the City's fleet prior to any procurement actions.

The replacement boat has met the Fleet Officer's eligibility criteria for replacement. The Fleet Service Center Managers have inspected the boat to be replaced and determined that the unit should be retired due to reliability issues.

The department's recommendations for the new boat have been reviewed by Fleet Services to ensure the new boat is appropriate for the specified use.

If a contract is not secured, maintenance of the Waller Creek Tunnel would be hampered which could lead to damage to the tunnel and surrounding areas due to the water not being properly diverted to Lady Bird Lake. The Waterloo Park Inlet Pond will also become overrun with trash without the weekly trash and debris maintenance.
