

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

EMERGENCY MEETING THURSDAY, AUGUST 31, 2017

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in an Emergency Called meeting on Thursday, August 31, 2017, at Austin City Hall, 301 West 2nd Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Adler called the meeting to order at 10:24 a.m.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION

- Discuss and take appropriate action related to the effects of Hurricane Harvey.
 Presentation was made by Juan Ortiz, Director, Homeland Security and Emergency Management;
 Lauraine Rizer, Real Estate Officer, Office of Real Estate Services.
- 2. Authorize negotiation and execution of a 30-day sublease with seven 30-day extension options for approximately 64,000 square feet of space, located at 7000 Metropolis Drive, Building 3, from 6 30th Street, LLC, for use as an emergency shelter for Hurricane Harvey evacuees, in an amount not to exceed \$424,960.00 (District 2).
 - The motion authorizing negotiation and execution of a 30-day sublease with seven 30-day extension options with 6 30^{th} Street, LLC was approved on consent on Council Member Renteria's motion, Council Member Casar's second on an 11-0 vote.
- 3. Authorize negotiation and execution of a 30-day lease with seven 30-day extension options for approximately 96,000 square feet of space, located at 7000 Metropolis Drive, Building 3, from MET CENTER PARTNERS-11 LTD, for use as an emergency shelter for Hurricane Harvey evacuees, including \$100,000 for temporary lighting and building restoration in an amount not to exceed \$591,520.00 (District 2).
 - The motion authorizing negotiation and execution of a 30-day sublease with seven 30-day extension options with Met Center Parnters-11 LTD was approved on consent on Council Member Renteria's motion, Council Member Casar's second on an 11-0 vote.

Mayor Adler recessed the meeting at 10:53 a.m. without objection.

Mayor Adler reconvened the meeting for adjournment at 12:37 a.m. The meeting was adjourned without objection.

The minutes were approved on this the 28th day of September 2017 on Council Member Garza's motion, Council Member Casar's second on a 10-0 vote. Council Member Troxclair was absent.
