The Firefighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel's Civil Service Commission has been established to ensure general compliance with applicable provisions of Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code, the local Civil Service Rules established by the Commission, and any current agreements between the City of Austin and associations representing firefighters, police officers and emergency medical services personnel. The Commission may take action on matters related to promotion, appeals of promotional exams, suspension and termination as well as other matters regarding firefighters, police officers and emergency medical services personnel in accordance with the above-mentioned statutes, rules, and agreements.

In accordance with applicable provisions of Chapter 143 of the Local Government Code, the City Manager has appointed Jolsna Thomas to fill a vacancy on the Commission created when a current

commissioner will no longer seek his reappointment to serve on the Commission after his term expires. The City Council is respectfully requested to confirm the appointment of Jolsna Thomas, to the Firefighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel's Civil Service Commission for a term of November 1st, 2017 through November 1st, 2020. She meets the statutory prerequisites for appointment to the position.
