# Current Agreement

- Agreements with school districts are authorized by state law
- Original AISD agreement is from 1994 with 3 amendments to address specific issues, processes, or development of new campuses
- Grandfathers AISD projects to 1994 regulations
  - ► Allows over 25% IC for 3 campuses in BSZ: Village at Western Oaks (50%), Boone (31%), and Kiker (38%)
  - ► Allows up to 25% IC for all other schools in BSZ
  - Requires "no discharge" water quality treatment or WPD approved alternative at all campuses

# Current Agreement

- ▶ June 2017 agreement allows transfer of 6.225 ac of IC from Travis Country site to Bowie H.S., but not to other campuses
- Not all of Travis Country IC needed for Bowie
- Council directed staff to bring back amendment to allow Travis Country IC to be used at other BSZ schools

### Proposed Amendment

- Only applies in the Barton Springs Zone
- Keeps impervious cover limit from current agreement, but allows transfer of IC from Travis Country "bucket" to meet that limit
- Requires tracking of Travis Country transfers
- Keeps requirement for non-degradation water quality controls, but allows off-site treatment of existing development to meet requirement

#### Proposed Amendment

- Includes City of Austin agreement that certain campuses won't be able to meet non-degradation on-site and remaining pollutant reduction would be achieved through off-site treatment
  - ► Zilker: pollutant reduction equivalent to 25% IC
  - ▶ Barton Hills: pollutant reduction equivalent to 15% IC
  - Baranoff: pollutant reduction equivalent to 5-10% (under review by CoA) IC

Note: SOS non-degradation = 0% impervious cover (IC)

#### Proposed Amendment

- Allows a single site-plan to include a non-contiguous area for water quality treatment
- Provides that off-site control doesn't trigger compliance for entire site at location of off-site control
- Allows impervious cover removed from Akin tract at Bowie H.S. to go back into bucket

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the proposal because:

- ▶ It is consistent with the existing agreement in terms of limiting impervious cover and providing non-degradation water quality treatment; while
- Providing AISD flexibility to redevelop existing, space limited campuses; and
- Authorizes the use of undeveloped Travis Country IC as mitigation.
