a. Commission discussion on regular meeting structure, including the idea of community panels for innovation oversight.

Discussion around the meeting structure was had. The suggested framework was for each working group to retain monthly updates, but to have each meeting more focused on one working group, including both the working group update and the speakers. This new structure would begin with the Digital Inclusion working group at the November meeting, and rotate through the Knowledge, Information, and Data Stewardship group second; the Technology, Infrastructure, and Innovation group third; and the Transparency and Civic Participation group fourth.

Motion to adopt the new meeting structure was proposed by Chair Floyd, seconded by Commissioner Pitts. The motion passed on a 7-0 vote, Commissioner Newell absent.
