ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The intent of the additional funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is to assist with Continuum of Care services that lost capacity in recent years and is considered one-time funding with an allocation period of two years from 2017 to 2019. The requested increase of \$249,091 represents the difference between the amended FY 2017-18 grant award of \$886,287 and the initial, or approved, FY 2017-18 grant award of \$637,196. The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Austin Public Health Department's need for continued funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
