DC Action:	The motion to support that the project is in compliance with the city's design and sustainability standards, with three stipulations, was made by E. Taniguchi; seconded by Vice Chair M. Gonzalez; approved on a unanimous [6-0-1] vote; B. Luckens recused; C. Kenny, B. Frail, M. Henao-Robledo, and K. Halloran were not present.

DESCRIPTION OF THE DESIGN COMMISSION'S STIPULATIONS FOR PROJECT SUPPORT

The Design Commission supports the project is in compliance with the city's design and sustainability standards with the following conditions:

- 1. The project team shall re-examine the placement of picnic tables to shade them as much as possible. This could mean either re-locating the tables under existing trees or planting new trees adjacent to the tables.
- 2. The project team shall provide a security solution for the openings between the roof and top of wall on the new restroom facility, to prevent an individual from accessing the interior of the restroom by scaling the wall. Multiple assaults have recently occurred in this area confirming this measure is necessary.
- 3. The project team shall re-examine the sidewalk along Chicon Street for width and location. The DC recommends a landscape buffer between the sidewalk and street in addition to increasing the width of the sidewalk.

The Design Commission has appreciated the opportunity to review and comment on this project.
