ORDINANCE NO.
AN ORDINANCE WAIVING CERTAIN FEES FOR THE SALVATION ARMY PROPOSED WOMENS AND CHILDREN'S SHELTER.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:
PART 1. Findings.
(A) The Salvation Army serves a valuable public purpose by serving Austin's vulnerable populations with basic survival services.
(B) The Salvation Army Women and Children's Shelter, when built, will address an unmet critical community need by serving and sheltering women and children experiencing or facing homelessness.
(C) The Salvation Army Women and Children's Shelter will bring expertise and resources that are otherwise unavailable, and it is in the public interest for the shelter to maximize its available resources to serve this vital public and community interest.
PART 2. Council approves the waiver of the following fees associated with the construction of the Women and Children's Shelter: Fees for the purchase of water meters for the facility:
3" Compound meter: Meter cost: \$1,876.70 Water CRF \$86,400.00 WWCRF \$35,200.00
3/4" Irrigation Meter Meter Cost \$245.47 Water CRF \$8,100.00
Total fees waived: \$131,822.17
