- -Immediately share the Bates' Gentrification and Displacement Study with Task Force members and the public;
- Coordinate with the UT researchers to develop a timeline and budget for the production of the UT Gentrification Report with a drilldown of at least 4 neighborhoods representative of the different categories described in the research by May 1, 2018;
- -Discuss with the UT researchers relevant studies that have investigated the displacement of small businesses to identify potential research activities and;
- Place an item on the February 2, 2018 meeting agenda for discussion and possible action on the resources and budget allocation to support the research activities of the UT researchers.
