Project Initiation



- 2009 PARD's Park Patrol Unit was absorbed by Austin Police Department (APD), partnership conceived
- 2010 PARD's Park Ranger Unit was established to work closely with the APD Park Patrol Unit
- 2011 During Capital Project Needs Assessment, two overlapping projects for PARD and APD were identified as an opportunity for a Joint-Use Facility







Project Initiation (cont.)



- 2011 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) was established September 2011
 - Formed a partnership between the PARD Park Ranger Unit and APD Park Patrol Unit and formalized an agreement to develop a Joint-Use Facility as part of a future Bond program

2011 Representatives from PARD and APD collaborated to determine a program and site for the Joint-Use Facility







Planning Phase



- □ 2012 City Voters approved Proposition 16: Public Safety to provide funding for designing, constructing, improving and equipping police fire and EMS facilities. Facilities projects to include renovations, expansions and new public safety facilities
- 2013 PARD offers Nash Hernandez Building as location for the Joint-Use Facility and also integrates the Nash Hernandez into the Holly Shores/Edward Rendon Festival Beach Master Plan
- 2014 Project Charter established between the Park Rangers and the Park Patrol Units







Funding Synopsis



- 2012 Nash Hernandez Building Assessment
 - PARD 2006 Bond \$343,847
 - Building Assessment and early design based on PARD office needs
 - Necessary abatement of building to prepare for construction
- 2012 APD Bond funding for Park Patrol Police facility
 - FY12 Proposition 16 Appropriation \$2.0M
- 2017 Revised Architectural Project Budget Est: \$6.7M
 - □ Planning/Design Budget Summary as of Dec. 2017
 - Appropriated \$1,992,300.00
 - Encumbered \$ 493,452.95
 - Obligated \$ 856,193.05
 - Balance \$1,136,106.95
