C14H-1977-0008 Old Depot Hotel 504 E. 5th Street

PROPOSAL

Demolish non-historic and non-original architectural elements, buildings, and additions to enable the restoration of the original walls and buildings of this complex.

PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The applicant proposes the demolition of a non-historic porte-cochere in the current parking lot, the parking lot itself, a non-historic exterior stair between the building fronting 5th Street and the building behind it (Building C in the attached plans), a non-original addition behind Building C, non-historic and non-original site walls, and a non-historic chimney to the façade parallel to 5th Street.

STANDARDS FOR REVIEW

The Commission's Standards for Review of applications for Certificates of Appropriateness include:

- Do not destroy the distinguishing original qualities or character of a building, structure, or site and its environment. Avoid the removal or alteration of any historic material or distinctive architectural features.
- Evaluate whether the demolition of the proposed features will adversely affect the historic character and context of the landmark property.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee recommended approval of the proposed demolitions. The applicant will return with plans for the restoration of the historic buildings.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Approve as proposed upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package.
