ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This budget amendment will allow the department to partner the Capital Area Food Bank to provide after school enrichment programs that provide nutritious food each weekday for children between the ages of 5 and 18 who may not have dinner available at home. The program will be offered at the Dove Springs, Montopolis and Turner Roberts Recreation Centers, allowing the centers to expand the scope of their after school programs. The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Parks and Recreation Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
